Honorable Supervisor Harris & Mayor Byrd, Dr. Shannon Vincent-Raymond,

As you know, President Biden and Vice President Harris's American Rescue Act has passed in U.S. Congress and is now law. The State of Mississippi will receive \$6 billion from the passage of this measure. Specifically, the City of Moss Point will receive \$2,790,000 from the portion of the allocation specifically from the \$97 million appropriated for Mississippi metro cities. There is a three-year deadline for spending these funds and expenditures can include water, sewer and internet infrastructure. The city has the opportunity to benefit from other portions of the state's \$6 billion appropriation through the legislative process or through state agencies depending on how the legislature processes the \$1.8 billion sent to the Legislature. The Moss Point Separate School District will receive its own direct allocation from the \$1.6 billion appropriation for K-12 education. I have also included additional appropriations that are also included in the state's \$6 billion appropriation that has not been mentioned above. Please be advised that the appropriations listed below are at the discretion of the receiving entities.


Please see the breakdown of how these funds will be allocated:

\$429 million for Mississippi's higher learning
\$258 million for smaller populated Mississippi cities
\$166 million for state projects
\$577 million for the state's 82 counties

- These funds are direct appropriations to Mississippi counties and are at the discretion of the governing authority (Board of Supervisors). Counties may choose to make additional appropriations to municipalities within their jurisdiction to assist financially outside of what the municipality has already received. However, the portions appropriated for municipalities and counties are separate appropriations.
